

PRADOFLOXACIN (Brand Name: Veraflox)

STRENGTH: 25 mg/ml Oral Suspension (Tablets available in the U.K.)

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: ORAL Best given on an empty stomach.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Quinolone class antibiotic approved for cats in the U.S. Designed for better activity against anaerobic bacteria and to have reduced retinal toxicity compared to other quinolone class antibiotics.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Diarrhea, vomiting. (These effects can be mitigated by giving medication with a small amount of food).

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Can reduced white cell count after 7 days of use.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate. SHAKE THE BOTTLE (OF ORAL SUSPENSION) BEFORE USE.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Product is good for 60 days after the container has been opened.
