ADEQUAN®

GENERIC NAME: Polysulfated Glycosaminoglycan (mostly chondroitin sulfate)

STRENGTH: 100 mg/ml injectable

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: INJECTABLE.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Anti-inflammatory effects by inhibiting enzymes that would perpetuate destruction of an arthritic joint. Also provides structural materials to assist in cartilage repair.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Occasionally a pet will develop an upset stomach temporarily but this is rare.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Can increase the tendency to bleed. This is not important in a normal animal but could be a problem for pets on anticoagulant therapy.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Compatible with most other arthritis medications. Dosing schedule generally follows an induction phase and then backing off gradually to a less frequent schedule depending on patient response.
