PSGAG (POLYSULFATED GLYCOSAMINOGLYCAN)

(BRAND NAME: Adequan)

.ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: INJECTABLE ONLY.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Disease Modifying Osteoarthritis Drug. Improves quality of joint fluid, has anabolic effects (builds muscle), and has anti-inflammatory properties.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: SPainful injection site. Vomiting/Diarrhea possible.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Can increase bleeding tendency.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Given as a series of injections: one injection twice a week until a good response is seen or 8 injections have been given (whichever comes first). After that, given as needed.
