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# AMOXICILLIN/CLAVULANIC ACID

**(BRAND NAMES: Augmentin, Clavacillin, Clavamox)**

**STRENGTH:** 62.5 mg, 125 mg, 250 mg, 375 mg, 500 mg, 625 mg, 1000 mg tablets as well as chewable and oral suspension.

**ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION:** ORAL

Can be given with or without food, see label for instructions.

**ACTION OF MEDICATION:** Antibiotic geared especially for Staphylococci and anaerobic infections but useful in many other infections as well.

**MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Vomiting, diarrhea, appetite loss. Usually giving the medication with food solves these issues but if side effects persist, it may be necessary to select another antibiotic.

**SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Specific serious side effects have not been reported but any individual animal can have a unique reaction.

**STORAGE:** Keep away from light. Store at room temperature. The oral suspension should be refrigerated though 24 hours without refrigeration is not a problem. The oral suspension should be discarded after 10 days.

**IF YOU MISS A DOSE:** Do not double up on the next dose. Give the next dose as scheduled.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** Often recheck cultures are performed after the treatment course is completed.
