MAROPITANT CITRATE

(Brand Name: Cerenia)

STRENGTH: 16 mg, 24 mg, 60 mg, 160 mg Tablets

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: ORAL. May be given with or without food. Fasting is recommended when used for motion sickness. In this situation, medication should be given 2 hours before travel.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: NK-1 Receptor blocker, Primarily an anti-nauseal but also had anti-inflammatory and pain relieving properties.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Occasionally a dog will vomit the pill immediately. This is mitigated by giving hte pill with a small amount of food..

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: The FDA has received sporadic reports of more serious reactions: facial swelling, incoordination, fever, muscle tremors, and convulsions.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Simply give the forgotten dose when it is remembered and time the next dose accordingly. This is typically a once daily medication.

OTHER INFORMATION: There is some potential for interactions with other medications. Be sure your veterinarian is aware of all supplements and medications your pet is taking.
