METOCLOPRAMIDE

(Brand Name: Reglan)

STRENGTH: 5 mg and 10 mg Tablets, also oral suspension (which is famously unpalatable for pets).

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: ORAL. May be given with or without food. Best given approximately 20 minutes before a meal.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Used for nausea, to improve stomach contractions, or to improve milk "let down" in nursing mothers.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Constipation.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Cats can experience a behavior frenzy. If this occurs, an alternative medication should be used. Can promote seizures in patients with a prior history of seizures.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Should not be used in patients with a history of seizures.
