PRAZIQUANTEL

(Brand Names: Droncit, Profender, Drontal and numerous anti-parasite products that include it as an ingredient)

STRENGTH: 23 mg and 34 mgTablets.

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: Oral, Topical and injectables are available.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Paralyzes and kills tapeworms. Also kills flukes and some round worms.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Tastes bitter. Some animals will vomit. Less than 5% of dogs and less than 2% of cats experience upset stomach with oral praziquantel. Injectable praziquantel will sting.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: None.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Not for use in kittens younger than 6 weeks of age or puppies younger than 4 weeks of age. Dead tapeworms are not visibly passed.
