# SELAMECTIN

**(BRAND NAMES: Revolution, Revolution Plus, Selarid, Paradyne, Revolt)**

**STRENGTH:** TOPICAL SOLUTIONS BASED ON PATIENT SIZE, AVAILABLE FOR BOTH DOGS AND CATS

**ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION:** Topical. Apply along back or back of neck where it cannot be licked away. Will absorb through the skin directly. Wait 2 hours after administration before bathing the pet. Do not apply to wet skin/fur.

**ACTION OF MEDICATION:** Kills fleas, mites, some ticks and some types of intestinal worms by enhancing inhibitory neurotransmitters.

**MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Approximately 1% of cats will develop hair loss at the application site. Drooling is likely should the product be licked.

**SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Vomiting, diarrhea, muscle tremors, lethargy. These have been reported in 0.05% or less patients.

**STORAGE:** Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

**IF YOU MISS A DOSE:** Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** Selamectin is considered safe to use in pregnancy and lactation. There could be important drug interactions with dogs who have the MDR1 mutation.
